**FLOAT DIMENSIONS: RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS \*NO EXCEPTIONS\***

**\*NOTE\*** FLOATS ARE TO BE BUILT FOR THE NARROW ENDS TO REPRESENT THE FRONT AND BACK OF THE FLOAT. FLOATS THAT ARE BUILT SIDEWAYS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

• **Attention Teachers:** If you are going to make this a class project, only your top 5 floats will be allowed to enter into the Florida Strawberry Festival Shoebox Contests, due to limited space.

- Float must be made of a cardboard shoebox no larger than 13” x 9”.
  - A complete decorated float should not exceed 16 1/2 inches tall.
  - Do not put wheels on float.
  - Do not put float on truck body.
  - Do not put shoebox on a piece of cardboard larger than shoebox.
  - Do not use motorized toys on float.
  - Do not use anything edible on float.
  - Only one applicant per float.
  - DO NOT BUILD INSIDE of the BOX (NO DIORAMA FLOATS).
  - NAMES ARE TO BE PLACED ONLY ON THE BOTTOM OF THE FLOATS.
- É FLOATS USING A PICTURE OF THE APPLICANT AS DECORATION WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

**Failure to comply with these rules as stated above will lead to disqualification.**

Samples of Materials: Paper-mache, cloth, foil, fringe, petal paper, etc. Most craft stores have a wide variety of things you can use. Let your imagination soar.
