FLORIDA STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL® CAMPGROUND ~ ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

• How many days can I ask to camp?

Our campground is only open during the Festival. You may book a site for the night before opening day and stay until the last night of the 11-day event. There is a two-night minimum stay requirement. You can apply to stay as many or as few as two nights, within those dates, as you like.

• How do you decide who gets a spot?

Our campground is popular! We receive far more reservation requests than we can accommodate. We fill the sites on a first-come, first-served basis depending on the campers' specifications and requested dates. The more flexible you are on your dates, the better your chances of getting a reservation. Our most requested days are Thursday, Friday, and Saturday; this makes them the hardest to get.

• Will my camper fit in the site?

All our sites are 20 x 50 ft. and are pull thru. You must keep all vehicles in this space (including pull vehicles.) There is no extra parking.

• Are all your campsites full hook up?

No. In fact we have very few full hook-up sites. We do offer a dump station, or you have the option of hiring the pump-out service available, at an additional expense. Our sites are either 50 or 30 amp. Most sites are 30 amp and water only. If you require 50 amp and sewer it is EXTREMELY unlikely, we will have a site available.

• What are your rates?

We charge per nights stayed. A two-night minimum stay is required.

Full hook-up: 50 amp is \$55, 30 amp is \$50

Water and electric only: 50 amp is \$50, 30 amp is \$45

• How can I reserve a camp site?

Our waiting list will open November 1st. You may call the office to be put on the list or for a quicker method, go to our website www.flstrawberryfestival.com and under the Info tab, go to Campground. There you will fill out an online form that includes your date of arrival/departure and camper requirements. These lists will be taken simultaneously. Please note, we give our festival vendors and concessionaires priority placement. They are placed up until November 1st when the waiting list opens to the general public.

• How will I know if I have a campsite?

We will start processing applications on November 14th. If we can fulfill your request, we will start contacting the applicants by email November 14th. It may take up to a week to contact those who were placed.

• When and how do I pay?

If your request for a campsite is approved, we will give you instructions via email. Full payment, in the form of a check or money order, will be expected within 30 days of notification. Failure to complete payment will forfeit your space and no refund will be provided. Cancellations must be made through the website 30 days prior to opening day for a refund.

• Can we enter the Festival from the campground?

Campground fees do not include general admission to the Festival. A complementary tram operates from this area to Gate 14 on a regular schedule from 7 a.m. to midnight daily.

• Where is the campground?

The physical address is 308 Seminole Lake Blvd. Plant City, FL 33564.

Coming from the west (Tampa) on I4:

Take exit 17 Forbes Road. Head south to Highway 92. At the light turn left (east) proceed approximately 2 miles. Turn right onto Seminole Lake Blvd. proceed .3 miles. Your destination is on your left.

Coming from the east (Lakeland) on I4:

Take exit 19 Thonotosassa Road and head south. Proceed approximately .7 miles to Baker Street/Hwy 92. Turn right (west). Proceed approximately .5 miles turn left onto Seminole Lake Blvd. proceed approximately .3 miles. Your destination is on the left.
