

# FLORIDA STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL®

## FAQs

- How many days can I ask to camp?  
You can apply to stay as many nights within the Festival dates as you like. However, there is a two-night minimum.
- How do you decide who gets a spot?  
Our campground is popular. We receive far more reservation requests than we can accommodate. We fill the sites on a first-come, first-served basis. The more flexible you are on your dates, the better your chances of getting a reservation. Our most requested days are Thursday, Friday, and Saturday; this makes them the hardest to get. Online requests be addressed first.
- Will my camper fit in the site?  
Most of our sites are 20 x 50 ft. You must keep all vehicles in this space (including pull vehicles.) There is no extra parking.
- Are all your campsites full hook up?  
YES. Our campground had major upgrades made to it this year and ALL SITES NOW HAVE FULL-HOOK UP AND 50 AMP. We also offer a dump station.
- What are your rates?  
Full hook-up with 50 amp is \$55 per night. A two-night minimum stay is required.
- How can I reserve a camp site?  
Our waiting list will open in December on our website [www.flstrawberryfestival.com](http://www.flstrawberryfestival.com) Click under the info tab then on camping. There you will fill out a form that includes your date of arrival and departure. We give our festival vendors and concessionaires priority placement. They are placed up until December when the waiting list opens to the public. Online requests will be addressed first.
- How will I know if I have a campsite?  
If we can fulfill your request, we will start contacting the applicants by email. The timeline is TBD.
- When and how do I pay?  
If your request for a campsite is accepted, we will give you instructions via email. Full payment will be expected within a week of notification. Failure to complete payment will forfeit your space. Cancellations must be made in writing at least 30 days prior to opening day for a refund.
- Can we enter the festival from the campground?  
Campground fees do not include admission to the festival. A complementary tram operates from this area to gate #14 on a regular schedule from 7 a.m. to midnight daily.
- Where is the campground?  
The physical address is 308 Seminole Lake Blvd. Plant City, FL 33564.  
Coming from the west (Tampa) on I4:  
Take exit 17 Forbes Road. Head south to Highway 92. At the light turn left (East) proceed approximately 2 miles. Turn right onto Seminole Lake Blvd. proceed .3 miles. Your destination is on your left.  
Coming from the east (Lakeland) on I4:  
Take exit 19 Thonotosassa Road and head south. Proceed approximately .7 miles to Baker Street/Hwy 92. Turn right (west). Proceed approximately .5 miles turn left onto Seminole Lake Blvd. proceed approximately .3 miles. Your destination is on the left.
